What we have been learning

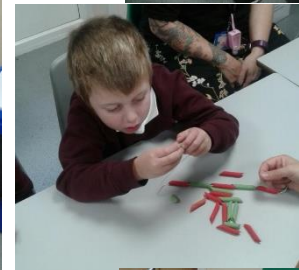
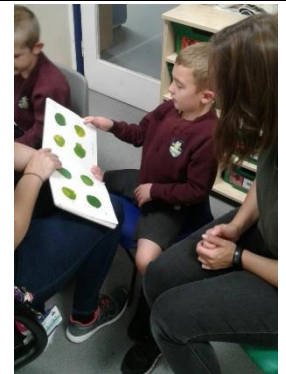
Some photos of our learning

The whole school topic this term is colours. The first book we shared in English was called 'mix it up', a book all about what happens when you mix two different coloured paints together. The children enjoyed using the book and seeing what colour was going to be next. We then used real paints and copied the book to mix our own colours, this was great fun. The second book we have been looking at is called 'blue hat, green hat' all about different colours of clothes. The children have enjoyed looking at the clothes and being able to try them on.

In maths we began the term by working on colour names and making patterns using colours. We have now moved on to numbers where the children are using Numicon to help practice their counting.

On a Friday afternoon we have been doing messy sensory for inclusion with the other children in Primary 1. They have loved exploring all the different coloured sensory materials.
