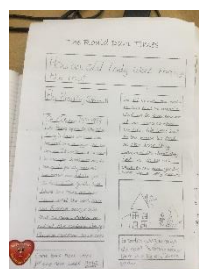
What we have been learning

Some photos of our marvellous work this half term.

This term in English we have been reading the story of George's Marvellous Medicine. Through this we have looked at writing instructions; including designing our own medicines. We have looked at adverts and designing products including alliteration and adjectives. We also wrote our own jingles to go with the product. Through drama in class we looked at questions and how to word and write a question. James played the character of George for us and the class asked him a range of questions. This inspired Sam, Harvey, Olivia, Amy, Alfie and Chloe who all wanted to have a go at being grandma Cranky! Harvey and Sam gave her a fantastic voice! Next we went on to writing a newspaper report about the events which happened that day on the Cranky's farm.

In Maths we have looked at numbers; adding and subtracting and multiplication. Some of the class were working on real life problem solving and using the 4 operations to solve this. Next we moved on to fractions which lead nicely into telling the time, as this helped with recognising quarter past and quarter to. This last week the class have been working hard on measuring; using either cubes, footsteps and hand spans to measure, or using a ruler and trundle wheel to measure larger distances of length.

The class were very lucky to visit the Botanical gardens, where they produced some detailed sketches and took some amazing pictures. The class are entering an art competition this term also, so watch this space to learn about our success.
