We have been able to visit Donnington Park twice where everyone had a fab time – it was lovely to see everyone playing together and looking after each other!

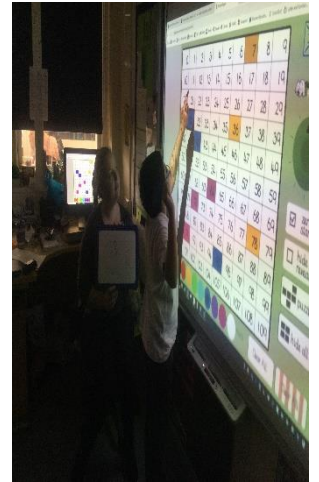
