What we have been learning this term:

What a busy term Pembroke Class have had! Everyone has been working extremely hard towards their own targets and engaging in all of our different sessions.

In English we have been exploring the story 'Superworm!'. We predicted what we thought might happen in the story before experiencing it in different ways, through a sensory story, yoga and story massage. We have written sentences about different parts of the story and also acted out different scenes!

In Maths we have been focusing on number; listening to different amounts, recognising numerals, finding a given number, finding one more than a given number, counting groups of objects and adding groups of objects together.

In science we have been exploring different minibeasts, we each made our own wormery, looking at what a worm needs and creating a nice home for them before creating a fact file about worms. We are now looking at the life cycle of the butterfly and currently have growing caterpillars in the classroom! We hope that they turn into butterflies before the half term.

In PE we have been focusing on ball skills, rolling a ball, throwing a ball and catching a ball. We have also been working towards our own individual physical targets in PE. We have also started Rebound Therapy again which everyone is really enjoying and building their confidence back up again – it has been lovely to see.
