What we have been learning this term:

Windsor are extremely proud of our achievements at the Agricultural Challenge. We were awarded second prize overall and £175. We are going to spend the money on some outside games and a special afternoon for our bubble (a pizza picnic is a popular choice!) We have also won a free day trip on a barge, which we are hoping to go on near the end of term. We were awarded first place for our fantastic 3D fox and our cress seed diaries. We enjoyed learning about what seeds need to grow and how to look after them. We measured the cress and were impressed to see how fast it grew. We also did experiments to find out what happens when we don't water the seeds and if we leave them in the dark. In Maths, we have been developing our understanding of positional language, by programming our beebots. We have been giving and following instructions, and really enjoyed pretending to be beebots ourselves;



our friends gave us directions to help the beebot find the flower. We have also been practicing how to cross the road safely, using the

school zebra crossing and our toucan crossing, in the classroom. Students were able to use positional language, including left and right, to explain to others how to cross the road.

We have continued to practice using money in our class snack shop, and are preparing for Windsor's takeaway snack shop, for the rest of the bubble. We have made posters, menus, order forms, tray liners and name badges. Our takeaway will open after half term.

Our year 11's have almost finished their ASDAN Transition Challenge coursework and will receive their gold certificates soon. Year 9 and 10 have been working super hard at their coursework too, so well done to all.
