What we have been learning this term:

Hello there, we are really enjoying our new topic minibeasts and mighty beasts, especially learning all about habitats, to include different types of jungles.

English: The Journey Home has been our book this term. Four endangered animals are looking for a new home, as their homes are disappearing or being destroyed. We have created posters, written letters and composed our own stories to accompany the story.
