## What we have been learning this term:

We have had a lovely start to the school year! The students in Wallingford have all enjoyed being back at Post16 and we have welcomed our new students to our class from main site. We started our term in September by learning about our namesake, Wallingford castle. We learnt about the original castle, named the various parts of it and made models of it. We then visited the Castle and had fun exploring the ruins.

We then started our topic this term which is Food. In our Life lessons we have been looking at food which is healthy for us and food which is unhealthy. We looked at how food labelling and the traffic light system can help us to make healthy choices. This has linked nicely with our weekly cooking sessions which are loved by the whole class! In Functional skills English some of us have been looking at food and where it comes from and others have been learning about what makes a good sandwich. We have written instructions for making a sandwich and then made it.

In Functional skills Maths we have been looking at number, counting, bigger/smaller than, and some addition. Some of us have been learning about tally charts and pictograms.

In drama with Anna, we have been learning our lines for our class play 'Stone soup' and collected food for the Food Bank which we del them this week.
