Cooking is another favourite. We have been cooking in the classroom this half term but I hope to start getting every one up to the kitchen after the half term break.

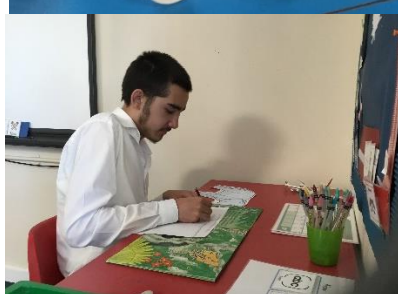
