This term we have been enjoying being back together and rebonding as a school and a class. We started the year by thinking about life as a journey- what we see, do and how we feel along the way. We used this idea to create word art clouds to represent where we have been (lockdown), where we are now (September) and where we are going (the future).

The students showed an interest in learning about castles. In geography, we found out where all the castles in the school are located. We then looked a bit more closely at the features of a castle and thought about what makes a strong, defensive castle and why. Using this knowledge, in art and design & technology we created papier mache castles. We then learnt about who would live and work in a castle and made Modroc people to go inside.
