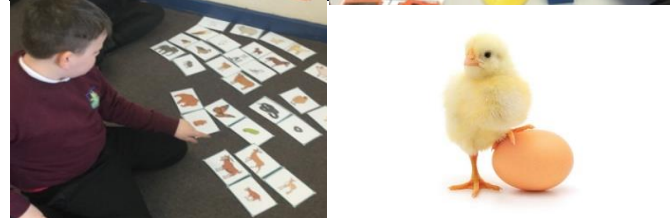
In science, pupils worked together in small groups to match the animal to its baby. They learned that baby reptiles are called hatchlings and that baby rabbits are called kittens!
