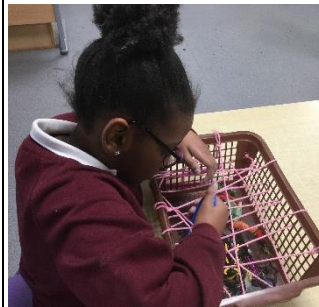
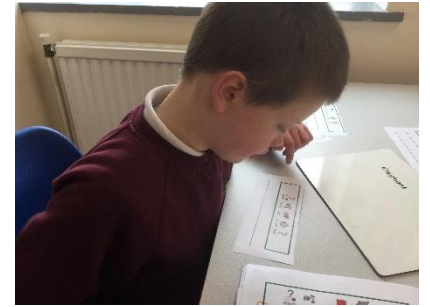
In maths we have been looking at 2D shapes, feeling them, counting the sides and corners, tracing them, making them out of lollipop sticks and going on a shape hunt.
