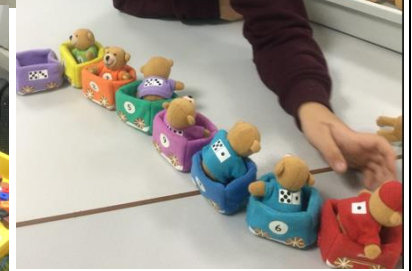

We have also been singing Mr Tumble's version of 'Aunt Polly had a dolly' to help us learn some new signs associated with the doctor's surgery. We enjoyed dressing up as medical professionals and caring for babies as well as attending important emergencies.

A big focus this term has been **mark making**. We have had lots of opportunities to create marks as using chalk outside, water paint brushes, playdough, paint, crayons, pens and even the interactive whiteboard. We have been looking at the way the letter 's' is formed and practicing using colouring and pencil control sheets. As well as looking at some letter formation we have been listening very carefully to the sounds in our environment and matching them to the pictures.

In **maths** our main focus has been counting, We have been learning to count fluently and understand the value of each number. Some of us have been looking at different ways to represent numbers up to 10 as well. To link in with mark making we have also been practising the formation of the number 1 which looks great on our Maths learning wall!
