What we have been learning this term:

It has been such a busy and wonderful first term back to school. We have spent lots of time getting to know each other and building relationships in the classroom.

In English we have been exploring the story 'We're All Wonders. We made a prediction around what we thought the story would be about based on the front cover before writing simple sentences around what we can do, labelling Auggie with descriptive sentences and sequencing what has happened in the story. We have also been working on our individual phonics, reading and comprehension targets alongside hand writing and fine motor skills.

In Maths we have been focusing on number, recognising numerals and counting objects as well as our number bonds to 10 and above! We have then applied this learning to addition, solving problems using learnt strategies.

In our topic sessions we have been learning all about ourselves and each other, drawing self-portraits, finding out our similarities and differences – both in how we look and what we like and don't like as well as talking about the people around us who are special to us.

We have also begun our Rebound Therapy sessions and everyone is so confident on the trampoline! We will be working on building core strength, gross motor skills and controlling our movements on the trampoline.

It has been such a pleasure getting to know everyone over the last term and we look forward to a very busy and exciting term up to Christmas! We wish you all a very lovely half term.
