In literacy we have focused on the story of the Enormous Turnip. The class have listened to the story, dramatised the story, re-written it as a class with our own twist of Nick being the old man and Emma as the old Women! The class also visit the school library and been focusing on accessing the books and listening to stories 1:1, in small groups or independently.

In Maths we have been focusing on number. Emma has played lots of tricks on us muddling up the class number line and we have had to problem solve the mistakes. Focusing on number order, rote counting and counting quantises, including quantises you cannot touch; someone skipping or jumping. We have begun moving onto addition and subtraction and focusing on number bonds, using a number line and using objects to support us.

In our leisure and play times with have been focusing on our social skills, through role play, construction, fine motor skills, creative and messy play. For the first time last week we visited Cheieveley Play Park. All the staff were immensely proud of everyone at the park, how they played and the transitions to and from the bus.

Through topic we have focused on ourselves and looked at our likes and dislikes. The class are thoroughly enjoying our new tool; Clicker and have been using the stories and sentence structure boards. The class have also looked at our senses; recognising smells and noises from round the home.
