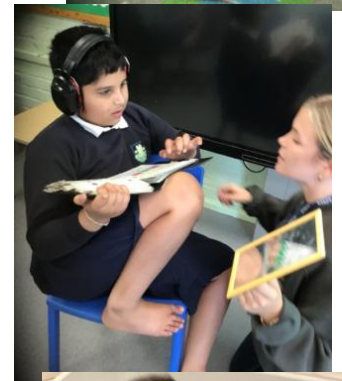
In **Maths**, we have been exploring measure. We have measured and compared body parts, ordered objects by size and used non-standard units (cubes) to measure objects in our classroom.
