What we have been doing this term:

Totnes Class have had a brilliant first term back at school and have been busy learning adapting to new routines in a new class.

In English, we have been looking at exploring non – fiction texts based around famous Tudor people. In addition to this, the class wrote diary entries from the perspective of a Tudor person – a maid and a member of the Royal family.

In Maths, we have explored number sequences and counting backwards and forwards in different steps. We have consolidated our knowledge of number and worked on our adding and subtracting, as well as even and odd numbers.
