What we have been doing this term:

What a wonderful first term we have had in Arundel Class! It has been lovely to see students become settled and relaxed in their new surroundings, making connections with peers and adults across the school.

Engagement in learning has been superb – we have covered so much already...!

In maths, we have learned about place value and how to apply this in column addition and subtraction. We have just begun a new topic, exploring properties of arithmetic.

In English, we have focussed on punctuation and grammar, looking at correct use of capital letters, the past tense and identifying subjects and verbs to support in writing complete sentences.

In science, students have really enjoyed learning about the particle model and the different properties of solids, liquids and gases. A highlight was making ice cream to explore how using salt can lower the melting point!

PSHE and RSE has been all about the Zones of Regulation. Students are showing great understanding of the different Zones and how to group the different emotions, considering how they feel in our bodies, such as the level of energy.

Our offsite visits to Thirtover have provided positive opportunities for connection-building and teamwork. Highlights have included grass sledging and the low rope course!
