English This term, the class have been developing their writing and storytelling skills. They used iPads and Clicker Writer to create sentences for weekend news. Our class reading book this term was the Hodgehog by Dick King Smith. We explored road safety through Max the hedgehog's adventures!

Maths we explored addition and subtraction through "About Me" activities. They solved problems using personal numbers and practised strategies with dominoes and blocks.
