What we have been learning this term:

Another fantastic term for Winchester! We have engaged in lots of learning across the curriculum and explored and enjoyed several new offsite opportunities.

This term in English we have been learning about Oliver by Charles Dickens. Winchester Class have shown empathy and understanding in exploring what it must have been like to live in Victorian England.

In maths we have continued our practise of place value, moving into associativity, commutativity and now into decomposition. Students have shown perseverance and determination and it has been a pleasure to see!
