Seasonal stuff!

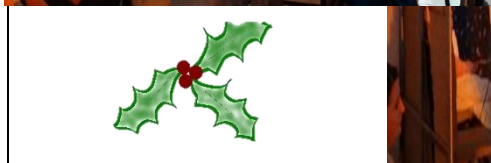
