What we have been learning this term:

Our class text

We've had a busy term in Conway learning all about transport. We've based lots of our learning on the story *The Journey Home from Grandpa's*.

English/Phonics

In phonics we have been listening to the sounds in our environment. This term our focus has been the street so we have been matching symbols to the sound of cars, buses, footsteps and construction work. Some of us have also enjoyed learning the phoneme and grapheme 's', 'a' and 't' through sensory play and messy mark making. In English we have been enjoying lots of interactive sensory stories to help us learn about the world around us. For example we have painted with grass, dug up icky sticky sand and trailed through mud as well as driving on the 'bumpy, bumpy road.' We have also been building two and three part sentences using colourful semantics. This has really helped us build up our key word vocabulary. Some of us have been matching symbols to different modes of transport mentioned in the story too.

Maths

In maths we have continued to work on our EHCP targets as well as focusing on number matching and addition.

Life lessons

To help us become more independent we have been using our role play costumes to practise dressing and undressing by ourselves. We have also loved looking at ourselves wearing our costumes in the mirror. We have also spent some time learning about hygiene and how to wash. We did this by bathing dolls and washing them with clothes. This really brought out our caring, nurturing side!

Communication and turn taking

This term's pass the bag theme has been transport. We have really enjoyed the songs and are associating different objects with everyday scenarios related to travelling.
