Topic: Transport

What we have been learning this term:

It's been a very quick and busy term for the New Year! This term our topic has been transport and we have enjoyed exploring this in different areas of the curriculum.

In English we have been exploring non-fiction texts, reading books around different modes of transport and answering questions around these. More recently we designed our own dream mode of transport – we have had some amazingly creative designs! We explained what all the different features were and drew our designs before writing answers to questions around them. In the last week we will be creating a junk model of our designs.

In Maths, we started the term exploring number. Some of us focused on our counting skills and others focused on identifying halves, of both shapes and quantities. We have also been exploring statistics, recapping our learning from last year on tallying before applying this to an investigation on coloured cars that drove past the school.

In Art we used paper mache to create a hot air balloon before creating a design and painting them.

In PE we have been working on our dancing, looking at how we could represent movement from different modes of transport into a dance routine. It has been wonderful to see everyone working in small groups and some students taking more leadership over groups.

In our cooking sessions we have been travelling around Europe, making croque monsieurs, pizzas, hummus, Spanish omelette and Belgium hot chocolate!
