What we have been doing this term:

This half term we have been looking at colour. In Maths we have been sorting coloured objects, finding out people's favourite colours and carrying out colour investigations. We have collected information in tally charts and some of us have been making pictograms. We have been practising counting in 1s and 5s to help us with counting our tallies. In English we have been reading The Day the Crayons Quit and Sam's Sandwich. We have looked at rhyming words and instructions. We have made sandwiches and toasted sandwiches in cooking to support our learning. We have been practising our life skills by visiting shops and buying ingredients for our cooking.
