Topic: Reduce, reuse, recycle

What's been going on?

Dover Class have been celebrating the success of their enterprise Doveroo, and have used some of the money raised to enjoy a lovely meal out as a class. We have also enjoyed other trips, especially visiting the recycling centre in Newbury and learning all about how and why we recycle. We have also been looking at the festivals in other cultures, and have been learning about Chinese New Year. We have been finding out the history of it, and how the Chinese people celebrate it.

In English, we have been looking at texts about our topic of reduce, reuse, recycle. Students have been looking at the texts, writing how they think the characters feel and predicting what happens next in the story, then writing their own versions of what happens next.

In maths, students have been revisiting 2D and 3D shapes, they have been sorting the shapes using Venn and Carroll diagrams and learning about edges, faces and vertices. The students have enjoyed working in small groups to sort the shapes in different ways and work out what type of shape it is by counting the vertices, faces and edges.

During our cooking sessions, the students have enjoyed creating some Doveroo cakes to sell and others to share with their families. Students have loved hearing all of the very positive feedback. The chocolate brownies, lemon drizzle cake and rocky road were all very popular. The students showed that they can work together in groups to produce high quality and delicious bakes, whilst also remembering the importance of food hygiene and kitchen safety. The class just love cooking and are keen to share their bakes with others.

Next half term, we will be continuing with our recycling topic. We plan to visit The Furniture Project and find out more about upcycling.
