Topic: Journeys

What we have been learning this term:

This term we have been looking at Journeys in stories. Most students have looked at the stories 'Journey home from Grandpa's' and 'Duck's day out'. One student looked at Journey's in their phonics reading books. The students have been: using props to act out stories, saying what happens next and ordering pictures from stories.

In maths our focus has been on measure. Most students have looked at big and small and long and short. They were: sorting objects, ordering objects and comparing them by size. They have also been doing activities with the prepositions: in, on and under.

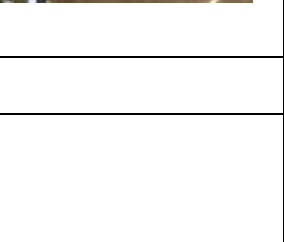
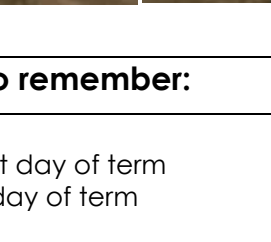
One student has been looking at weight and using comparison language to compare heavy and light objects. They have also been using balance scales to make estimates about which object will be heavier or lighter and testing this on the scales.

In Life Lessons this term we have been looking at emotions. The students have: watched adults make faces in a mirror and attempted to copy, looked at the emotions symbols and looked at toys and activities that make them feel happy or sad.

PE this term has focused on using the large climbing equipment in the hall. The children have been moving in different ways across the equipment. They have all loved this.

One pupil has been doing PE with another class and playing benchball. He was learning how to pass it to his peers on the ground and then how to be the one on the bench who has to catch it.
