What we have been learning this term:

What better journey to go on than a bear hunt? We've been up to lots this term and we're really excited to share it with you.

Maths

In maths we have been concentrating on number representations and how they can help us with our counting and adding. We have been enjoying 'The Numicon Song' to help us become familiar with the numbers they represent. We have been mating, ordering and even adding using Numicon.

English

In phonics we have been listening to sounds in the environment and matching them to pictures. Some of us having been practicing to blend sounds in order to read cvc words such as 'pat' and 'sat'! In mark making we are practicing our fine and gross motor. Some of us are also practising to write graphemes such as 's', 'a' and 't'. Our class sensory story this term has been 'We're Going on a Bear Hunt', we have been swishing through grass and exploring 'oozy mud'. Using illustrations as a stimulus, we have been listening to adults describe the pictures and building two and three part sentences using Colourful Semantics. We're looking forward to starting our 'Easter Hunt' sensory story and taking part in exciting activities based on what we have read and listened to as a class.

To add context to our class story which is all about a family going on a bear hunt, we have been exploring other types of families and looking at our own. We have loved looking at pictures of everyone's families and chatting about them. It has been fun learning the Makaton signs for mum, dad, brother and sister too!
