Wilf: Making a bench from a hay pallet in DT

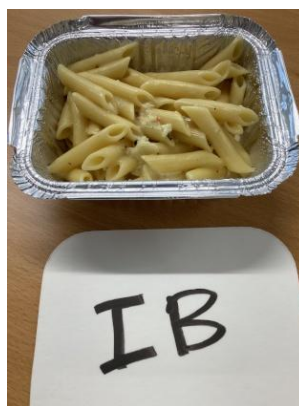
Teegan: Feeding the guinea pigs at the care farm
