We have many pots containing potatoes, tomatoes, peppers, garlic, spring onion, sweetcorn, carrots and even strawberries!

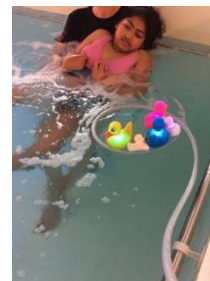
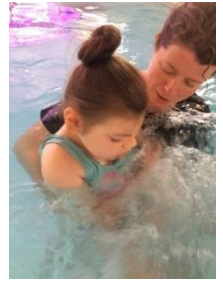
We also made some paintings of our favourite foods and 3D cardboard flowers using cardboard rolls with leftover eggshells in the centre and grew cress inside them.
