What's been going on

This half term, we have read two versions of Saint George and the Dragon and discussed their differences. We have used adjectives to describe the main characters and answered comprehension questions to demonstrate our understanding of the text.

In maths, we have been adding to and subtracting from 2-digit and 3-digit numbers. Students have been using tens frames and column methods to do this. It is wonderful to see students using their knowledge of number bonds and doubles to help them solve trickier calculations.

During one of our cooking sessions, students made picnic food. In small groups they made cheese and ham quesadillas, pizza rolls, flapjack and school cake. The following day they celebrated the King's Coronation having picnic in the park.

In Art and DT, Dover Class designed and created their own piece of Coronation themed artwork which was then joined together to form giant Coronation bunting! Students felt proud when they saw photos of their artwork outside and inside The Corn Exchange.

In PE with Oli, students have been learning how to play cricket. They have been working on their hand-eye coordination skills and batting technique, and fielding skills.
