A short term has been and gone with two four day weeks this term.

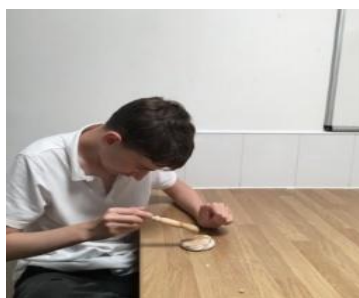
