What we have been doing this term:

It's been another wonderful term for Winchester.

Engagement in daily check-in has continued, exploring our awareness and understanding of each other's feelings.

In Book Detectives, we have built on our learning from last term to begin to unpick metaphors, similes and personification as we finish reading *Danny the Champion of the World*. We have applied our empathy and knowledge of Zones of Regulation to explore how characters react in certain situations, making links to the Social Emotional Chain Reaction.

In maths, we have begun learning about negative numbers and how they behave in addition, subtraction, multiplication and division calculations. Students have been able to identify their preferred visual aids and learning methods which is a great skill in itself!

In science, we have been learning about space. The students have looked at the solar system, naming all the planets in order of distance from the sun. They have learned how the Earth's tilt causes global seasons and how we have 24 hours in each day.

The highlight of this term has been our preparation and involvement in Castle Fest. Students took care and pride in designing canvasses, posters and sock snakes to raise money for the school.
