Oscar: In cooking we made Macaroni and cheese. It tasted so good and dangerously cheesy.

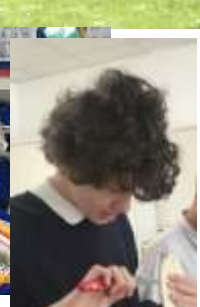
Ryland: I have really enjoyed learning about money in Maths.
