What we have been learning this term:

We have managed to fit a lot in to this last Summer term and everyone has been incredibly busy working towards their individual goals.

In English we have been learning the story of 'The Little Red Hen', using actions to memorise the story and develop our story language. It has truly been a group effort and it has been fantastic to see everyone joining in and retelling the story as a class.

In Maths, we explored time – learning the different parts of a clock and their role in telling the time before focusing on reading and creating o'clock and half past times. Some children also began to look at problem solving using time, moving forwards and backwards.
