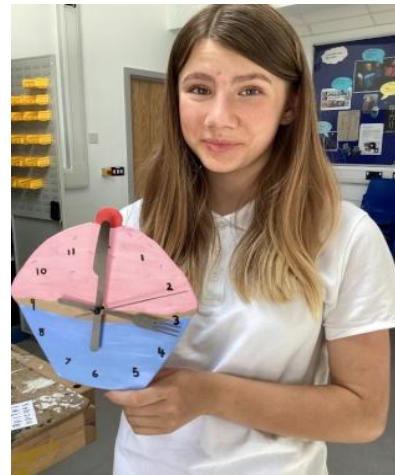
Science
