Topic: People and their Jobs

What we have been doing this term:

It has been a busy final term in **maths** as we have explored topics of both measurement and fractions. We have learned to estimate and record length, volume and capacity, applying these skills to practical activities such as cooking. We have also developed our understanding of fractions, using arrays, bar models, division and sharing methods to find $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$ and $\frac{1}{3}$ of different amounts.

In **English**, we have been focusing on poetry, particularly the work of Michael Rosen. We have explored a range of poetic techniques, including similes, alliteration, onomatopoeia and rhyme, and practised identifying these in different poems. Pupils then applied their understanding of these techniques to write their very own poems!

In **PSHE**, we have been learning about the internet, exploring both its benefits and potential risks. We discussed topics such as fake news, AI generated images, and the impact that edited and photoshopped images can have on people's self-esteem.

Each Tuesday morning, students have continued to enjoy sharing their **news**, whether it's about their weekends or exciting events coming up. The team and I have thoroughly enjoyed hearing about their experiences, and it has been wonderful to see pupils' confidence grow as they speak in front of the class and share their ideas with others.

In **Wow**, we have been developing key workplace skills such as teamwork, creativity and communication. Pupils completed a skills audit to reflect on their strengths and identify areas they would like to develop further as they move into the next academic year.

This term, we have made the most of the sunny weather by enjoying **off-site visits** to a range of local parks, including Shaw, Donnington and Victoria Park. Our favourite was definitely Dinton Pastures, where we spent a lovely morning by the water and exploring the local area.
