In science the students have learnt how plants reproduce, the different parts of a plant and their role in the cycle.

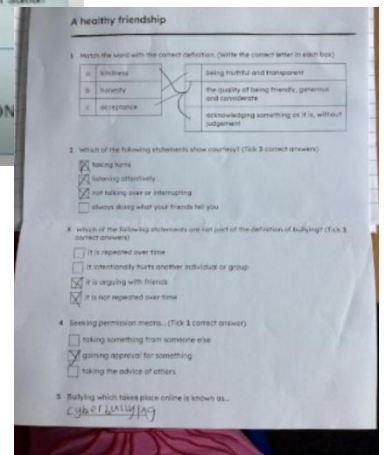
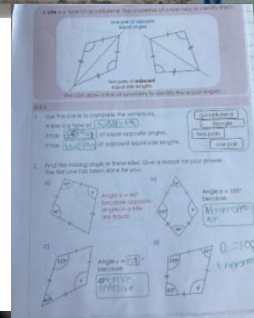
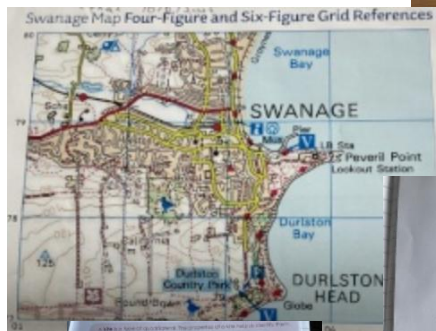
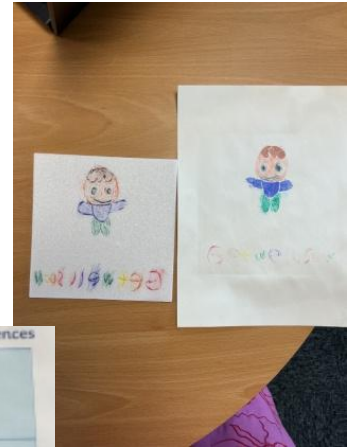
In humanities Arundel have learnt how to read a map with grid references, practised using a treasure island and progressed to real life maps.
