What we have been doing this term:

Our topic 'My Body' has seen the children learn lots of different body parts and understanding the functions of different components. We have been exploring all of our senses and smelling, touching, seeing, tasting and hearing in a range of different contexts and environments.

We have been enjoying the trampoline in the hall for Rebound therapy. All the children have been following verbal and pictorial prompts and requests to develop their skills both on and off the trampoline to keep safe.

This term some of us have also been out into the community down to the Bandstand in Victoria park to listen and enjoy some of the different classes performances.

The sunshine has made our classroom and learning areas extremely hot so we have been enjoying lots of water and sensory play, making and eating ice creams and ice pops. The children's communication around wanting these to help cool and regulate has grown considerably and we are very proud of them! Furthering from this, we have seen an incredible development in all of their growing communication skills. Whether this is through use of communication books, core boards, Makaton or verbal all children have made excellent progress and are communicating their wants and needs far clearer than previous terms. Emotions and feelings is another area in which all children have developed their communication skills. Each day all children complete their emotion check ins and are beginning to explain why they are feeling the way they have said.

In maths we have been exploring measure and shape we have been learning the names and practicing drawing regular and irregular shapes using rulers. Some of our children have even started to look at angles and identifying acute and obtuse angles.
